

COOKIE CREDIT TRANSFER

In the spirit of Girl Scout sisterhood, a girl may transfer her camp cookie credits to another Girl Scout. This is an individual girl-and-parent decision, one that will enable more girls to benefit directly from the cookie sale by experiencing the camaraderie and outdoor living that is camp. This is not a decision to be made by the troop leader or the Product Sales Coordinator.

- The transfer form must be completely filled out by the girl sharing her credit with another Girl Scout. It must be signed by her parent or guardian. Transfers may be made in this format only.
- The form may be photocopied. A girl may transfer her credit before she knows the exact amount of cookies sold.
- Only one transfer may be received per girl. If two individual girls transfer credit to the same girl, the form received by GSSNE first will be the credit given to the camper.
- A camper may use the gift of credit for no more than 50% of the camp fee for one session.
- A scout may not "split" or share credits to more than one scout.
- Girls may receive cookie credits from both their sister and another scout. Both transfers require individual forms.
- This form must be received at GSSNE by 5 pm APRIL 22, 2016.
- Unused cookie credit supports the activities, equipment, and upkeep of our GSSNE camps.
