

# Gold/Silver Award Process Frequently Asked Questions

## **Pre-Requisites:**

- Silver one Journey
- Gold Silver Award and one Journey or two Journeys if didn't earn Silver
- Girls must complete the Journey appropriate for the age group she is currently in

#### **Choose Project**

- Based on girl's interest
- Take Action Project based on identified community need and root problem
- Projects must be community based; outside Girl Scouting
- Silver-Must be an individual project or 2-3 in a small group
- Gold-Must be an individual project

## **Project**

- Take Action not Short Term, must have a sustainable impact
- Gold Awards projects must be sustainable, Silver must show that sustainability is possible
- Plan to complete report within two weeks of project completion
- Keep a time-log as you work on the project. Do NOT wait until you write your report.

#### Application – Use GSRI forms

- Submit at least 1 month prior to project start date
- Type or print neatly critical
- Signatures from project advisor (not parent), Gold award must be someone with expertise in project focus. If the parent is the troop leader she/he should have the asst. leader sign off on the pre-requisites as well.
- Submit complete application to Higher Awards Committee
  - o Committee meets monthly, proposals and reports are reviewed weekly
  - o Gold Award applicants are assigned a mentor
- Letters/emails are sent indicating approval of project or more information needed
- Please give as much information as possible

# Gold/Silver Award Process - Frequently Asked Questions

# Reports - Use GSRI forms

- Typed or printed neatly
- Silver-must demonstrate that sustainability is possible
- Gold-must verify project sustainability (letter of commitment, etc)
- Hours
  - o Calculate total number of hours on each sheet.
  - o Hours may begin on approval date
  - o Gold projects = 80 hours, 20 hours may be pre-approval
  - o Silver projects = 50 hours, 15 hours may be pre-approval
- Should be submitted within two (2) weeks of project completion
- May include photos, news clippings, etc.
- The deadline to submit reports is September 30<sup>th</sup> if you are bridging to the next level.
  - o Please do not wait until the last minute.
  - The committee may have additional questions once the report is submitted.
    We recommend that reports be received by August 1 to allow for clarification if needed.
