_____, a member of Troop #_____, has my permission to participate in the 2016 Cookie Sale Program. We agree to honor the official start date of December 19, 2015 and that she will have adult supervision and guidance while selling cookies at all times. My signature below indicates agreement with the guidelines listed below.

- 1) Girls participating in the Cookie Sale Program MUST be officially registered with Girl Scouts of the U.S.A.
2) I accept financial responsibility for All cookies received and all money collected. If I have any questions or concerns with product or money in my possession, I will notify the troop leader immediately.
3) I understand that ALL cookie proceeds are Troop & Council property and "the funds are for Girl Scout activities and are not to be retained by individuals as their property" in accordance with GSSNE guidelines.
4) I agree that ALL cookie money collected must and will be given to my Girl Scout's Troop by the Council-set deadline or any earned recognition items will be withheld until Council receives the outstanding balance.
5) I understand that if my account is delinquent, and not brought current prior to the deadline or ordering the time-sensitive recognition items, Council will not be obligated to reissue, replace, substitute, or refund the value of said recognitions.
6) I understand that I am responsible for paying for ALL of the cookies my daughter or I take on behalf of her troop and GSSNE. I understand that failure to pay for those cookies in full, by the established deadline that both my daughter(s) and I may be restricted from further girl scouting activities until the cookies are paid for in full.
7) I understand that unsold cookies cannot be returned to the Council and MUST be paid for in full by the established deadline.
8) I understand that adults serve in a supporting role for girls and should not assume sole responsibility for sales.
9) Girls and their families must adhere to all safety GSUSA safety guidelines when selling cookies and also when she is marketing the products online. Girls must take the internet safety pledge before going online and follow the specific guidelines established by GSUSA.
